The East Colfax Avenue Corridor

The six-mile span between Colorado Boulevard and I-225 is home to a vibrant, diverse mix of individuals, families, cultures, businesses, and community organizations. East Colfax is poised for enhanced infrastructure and amenities with the planned Bus Rapid Transit project and the recent Opportunity Zone designation, which, unfortunately, also will increase the threat of displacement of existing residents and businesses.

IMPACT EAST COLFAX is a collaboration between Urban Land Conservancy (ULC) and The Fax Partnership (The Fax), developed to preserve the existing communities along the corridor by building equitable, affordable commercial and residential developments on the East Colfax corridor. To advance the vision, provide direction, and oversee construction of the projects, the collaborative is assembling **two community-focused Steering Committees** (one for Denver and one for Aurora).
